Admission Requirements:

Criteria for admission into the Cambridge AICE program include a Level 4 or 5 on the most recent FCAT Reading and Math tests, a completed recommendation form by a teacher, a confidential guidance recommendation, and a copy of your most recent report card.

Private school or out of state students need a 3.0 GPA and a 77 percentile or higher in both Reading and Math on Nationally Normed Exam. You will need to provide your most recent grade report card, as well as Nationally Normed exam results.
