With only seven weeks left in this quarter, it's more important that students stay hyper focused on their academics and grades. We are experiencing higher than usual failure rates with some students so we have asked our teachers to maintain contact with you if your student is failing a class. Our students need to understand that they must earn credits in order to be promoted from middle school to high school. Any student who fails a quarter of a core academic class will be required to do the following:

- 1) Take a computer-based mastery test to possibly earn credit
- 2) Enroll in an Edgenuity course to show mastery (70% required)

I want to encourage all of our parents to sit down and review their own students' progress in the classroom. If the grades are acceptable, please encourage your child to continue to work with fidelity and to push the limits of their academic success. If the grades are not up to par, please take the opportunity to contact the teachers or school counselors to see what else can be done. It is a teachable moment that parents can take to instruct their student on the importance of succeeding academically! Moving forward, parents can continue to check on their students' grades via Focus. Students wishing to do tutoring at home can partake in the "Connect with Lee" an online tutoring program. You can find information at www.leeschools.net.

For family planning, Thanksgiving break is November 20th-24th, followed by Winter Break December 22nd (half day) through January 8th. All schools will be closed during those days. The second semester/quarter three will begin January 9th. Until then, please remember that school attendance is vitally important for student academic success. Our 6th grade students are definitely leading the way in attendance excellence and won our monthly contest for free ice pops for all!

In closing, as November is marked by our national day of Thanksgiving, I just wanted to take the opportunity to say THANK YOU to all of our students, faculty, staff, and stakeholders for making Bonita Springs Middle Center for the Arts a fantastic place to work and celebrate learning. Before your child can begin the 7th grade he/she must have documentation of having received the following immunizations: TDaP booster (Tetanus, Diphtheria, pertussis) after the age of 10.

We encourage all parents to have their child seen by a private physician or health care provider in the community prior to the busy summer season to receive the required immunizations. Private physicians and clinics charge according to their established fees. Vaccines required for children are available free of charge from all Lee Health Department facilities. Remember you must bring your child's immunization records with you to help determine what immunizations are required and to provide the information necessary to fill out the Florida Certificate of Immunization Form DH-680.

How has choir positively affected your time at BSMCA?


Choir makes the long days at BSMCA more fun!
